Dr. John D. Hromi (APQO member number 0080) is a very well-known quality guru. He is a doctor of engineering and Professor Emeritus of Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT). He founded the Center for Quality and Applied Statistics which now bears his name, and for eight years served as Frederick H. Minett Distinguished Professor. Dr. Hromi is a Fellow of the American Society for Quality (ASQ) of which he was past President and Chairman of the Board. In recognition of his major accomplishments, he received several awards from the ASQ such as E.L. Grant (1987) Award for establishing and implementing educational programs in quality; Edwards Medal (1993) in recognition of his outstanding leadership in the application of modern quality control methods, and the Jack Lancaster Award (1996) for implementing a strong international relationships. He has a BS Degree in Mathematics from Carnegie Institute of Technology, a Mlitt Degree in Mathematics from University of Pittsburgh and a doctorate in Engineering from the University of Detroit. He is honorary member of the Philippine Society for Quality and of the Czech Society for Quality. He was editor of The Best on Quality book series of the prestigious International Academy for Quality of which he is a member.
